All food vendors require a Harris County Temporary Food Permit. Each vendor is required to obtain a permit and should be purchased no later than two business days prior to the event to avoid a late fee. If a vendor has more than one booth, each booth will need a separate temporary food permit. Any vendor that does not purchase their permit within that timeframe will incur a cost of twice the regular temporary permit fee.

Harris County Fire Marshal's Office (HCFMO) permits and inspects temporary events in unincorporated Harris County. Please call 713-274-1730 or 281-436-8030 or visit [www.hcfmo.net](http://www.hcfmo.net) for application and requirements.
